Public Availability Notice of Hazardous Materials Information

The Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act of 1986, also known as Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) requires emergency planning, and emergency notification of accidental releases.

The public has access to a variety of chemical specific data and information of facilities reporting under the provisions of the Act. Citizens and businesses seeking information on any of the noted provisions should contact the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council in writing or at the address below.
