


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

AGENDA ITEM #1-3 Call to Order & Introductions

There was no member who wished to give an invocation. The chair, Bruce Porter, called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Roll call was taken. The Pledge of Allegiance was said.

AGENDA ITEM #4

Minutes of the November 30, 2023 Meeting

The chair, Bruce Porter, entertained a motion to accept the draft LEPC meeting minutes of the November 30, 2023 meeting.

A motion was made by Mathew Marshall to approve the minutes of the August November 30, 3023 LEPC meeting as presented. The motion was seconded by Jason Wilkins and passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #5 LEPC Membership

The position of Vice Chair is still open for any member wishing to be nominated. There was a nomination submitted for an alternate member to an existing primary member. The nominee was Jenifer McBride, the primary member was Rick Pardo from Lee County Mosquito Control.

A motion was made by Mathew Marshall to approve the nomination and submit it to the state for approval. The motion was seconded by Jason Wilkins and passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #6 Presentation

There was no presentation this quarter, however Charity Franks reminded members and guests that Matt Marshall would be giving an EPCRA/EPLAN workshop immediately following the LEPC meeting.

AGENDA ITEM #8 SERC Meeting Recap

The staff discussed the subjects brought up at the January SERC Meeting and Hazmat Symposium including, The Thomas Yatabe Award Presentation, The PFAS firefighting foam disposal initiative, and The Offshore Hazmat Pilot program. The major discussion points during the SERC meetings were the updates presented were the success of the Hazmat Symposium, a presentation from the Winter Park High School NJROTC Emergency Response Sciences program, also a presentation by- Brevard County Fire Rescue about a release of anhydrous ammonia incident at a facility in Port Canaveral. Ms. Franks announced that the 2024 Hazmat Symposium was a huge success, and that first responders from all over the country were able to attend and participate in training and information sharing.

Bruce Porter shared that several attendees of the SERC were exposed to COVID during an outing.

AGENDA ITEM #9 Southwest Florida LEPC Training Subcommittee Report

Chief Marshall shared that the LEPC was able to send 25 personnel to the Hazmat Symposium as part of our HMEP grant funding. He announced that the Hazmat Symposium was very well attended. So well attended, that there were too many applying competitors for the team competition and some applicants had to be turned away. During the competition, there were even two teams from out of state. Next year, we aspire to use our training funds to send at least 20-25 people. He announced that the LEPC received our grant contract from the state in January so we are able to resume sending first responders to training. He announced that he is seeking approval from the LEPC for a training proposed by Sarasota County, a Hazmat Incident Training. A motion was made by Jason Wilkins, and was seconded by Dave Glen. It passed unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM #10 Tier II Reporting and E-Plan Update

Matt Marshall shared a suggestion from Collier County Fire Chiefs for a Lithium Ion micromobility training put on by Hazard 3. The LEPC could potentially use the remaining funds after the Hazmat Incident Training and part of next year's funds for this course. A motion was made by Jason Wilkins to approve this plan, and was seconded by Dave Glen. It passed unanimously.

Matt Marshall shared that there would be a presentaion following the LEPC meeting on EPCRA. He announced that the state is around 50% compliant for Tier 2 Reporting. He shared that the due date is March 1 and urged anyone who had not submitted their Tier 2 report to go ahead and do so.

SERC LEPC Membership Categories:

Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPCs) must have representatives from the following occupational categories, as required in Section 301(c) of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act (EPCRA):

- 1. elected state/local officials;
- 2. law enforcement;
- 3. emergency management (civil defense in EPCRA);
- 4. firefighting;
- 5. first aid;
- 6. health:
- 7. local environmental;
- 8. hospital;
- 9. transportation personnel;
- 10. broadcast/print media;
- 11. community groups;
- 12. facility owners/operators subject to EPCRA;
- 13. interested citizens;
- 14. non-elected local officials;
- 15. water management district representative;
- 16. local option.

There should be a continued good faith effort on behalf of the LEPC chairperson to ensure that all of the occupational categories are represented on the LEPC.

Note: The following SERC categories are not EPCRA LEPC Membership Categories (§ 301(c)):

- First Aid
- Interested Citizen
- Non-elected Official
- Water Management District
- Local Option
- Local Environmental

Pursuant to 42 USC §11001(c), Establishment of local emergency planning committees, each local emergency planning committee "shall include, at a minimum, representatives from each of the following groups or organizations: elected State and local officials; law enforcement, civil defense, firefighting, first aid, health, local environmental, hospital, and transportation personnel; broadcast and print media; community groups; and owners and operators of facilities subject to the requirements of this subchapter."


